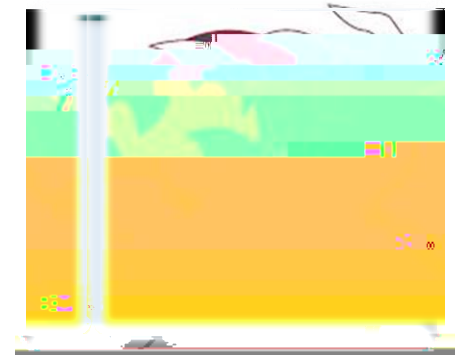

Absences

Failure to comply with New York State Immunization laws.

The illness, or child's reaction to it, requires more care than staff can provide or compromises the health and safety of others.

Fever over 100.0 degrees

Diarrhea

Vomiting

Undiagnosed rash

Child must be symptom-free for 24 hours before returning to school. (If the child is sent home, they are not to return until the second school day from the day of dismissal.)

child
must be treated for 24 hours, with no drainage from eye.

: until six days after the onset of the rash or all lesions have dried and crusted.

: until 24 hours after treatment has been initiated.

: allowed to return after the first treatment.

: until treatment has been initiated. A rea must be covered while in school.
